


5032-25 2010-14 Camaro Automatic L99 Oil Catch Can Installation

- 1. Install the mounting bracket to the oil catch can lid using the supplied Allen head bolt.
- 2. Apply Teflon Sealing Tape the to the supplied catch can fittings and Install the 3/8 fittings into the side of the can.
- 3. Remove the two nuts holding the factory airbox in place. Mount the catch can on the factory stud with the airbox mount on top of it. Tighten the two nuts back down. The inlet from the PCV will connect the rear facing fitting on the catch can. The outlet will face the front of the car and will connect to the intake manifold vacuum fitting



- 4. If your Camaro has an engine cover, remove it to gain access to the PCV hose.
- 5. Some Camaro models will have slip-on barbed style fittings, and others will have snap on quick connect fittings. If your Camaro has a short rubber hose running from the PCV to the intake manifold, simply apply a little engine oil to the barbs and slide the hose end covers over the hose, then slide the hoses over these fittings.

6. If your Camaro has quick connect style fittings, release the fittings by moving the tabs on the fitting to the side, then lift the fitting off. Cut the factory hose near the fittings, and slide the catch can hose over the factory plastic hose. It will be a snug fit, so a little engine oil on the factory tube will help the hose to slide on.



*If your factory hose is missing, or in poor condition UPR sells replacement quick connect fitting on our website.

Always check and drain the catch can more often in winter / freezing weather. If the water/oil mixture in the catch can is allowed to freeze it will cause damage to the catch can and internal components. Any damage due to freezing is NOT WARRANTY. You must dispose of the liquid collected in the catch can properly (with used waste oil) properly according to your local laws.
