UPR 05-14 Spherical Bushing

- 1) Remove the old bushing. We suggest soaking it with Liquid Wrench or a similar product to loosen it before removal. Using a small sledge hammer, drive the old bushing inward to loosen it. Then hammer it back out.
- 2) Clean the rust & paint from the housing bore using sandpaper or scotch-brite.
- 3) Remove the retainer ring / nut new bushing. Tap the new bushing into the rear end evenly until it seats. (putting the bushing in the freezer for a few hours will help it to install easier)
- 4) Apply loctite to bushing threads. Screw on retainer ring and tighten with pliers.
